

YOUR AGREEMENT WITH TEACHERS CREDIT UNION

Before we make arrangements for your flight, hotel, car rental, tour, cruise, or other trip, we require that you sign this form; your signature will signify your agreement with the following terms and conditions:

Teachers Credit Union acts as a sales agent for any airline, hotel, car-rental company, tour operator, cruise line, or other service provider named in your itinerary ("Suppliers"). TCU, and its employees, agents, officers, directors, stockholders, member-owner, successors, assigns and affiliates (collectively, "TCU") are not responsible for acts or omissions of the Suppliers or their failure to provide services or adhere to their own schedules.

By signing below, you hereby acknowledge the inherent risks and dangers associated with travel, including, but not limited to, the risk of serious personal injury, sickness or even death. You hereby fully assume, on behalf of your self and any minor children, all such dangers and risks, both known and unknown. TCU assumes no responsibility for and shall not be liable for any refund, personal injury, property damage, or other loss, accident, delay, inconvenience, or irregularity which may be caused by: (1) any defaults, wrongful or negligent acts, or omissions of the Suppliers; (2) any defect in or failure of any vehicle, craft, equipment, or instrumentality owned, operated, or otherwise used or provided by the Suppliers; or (3) any wrongful or negligent acts or omissions on the part of any other party not under TCU's direct control. You hereby knowingly and freely release TCU, and agree to hold TCU harmless, from any and all liability, claims, actions, and causes of action arising directly or indirectly out of anything covered by this paragraph.

TCU has no special knowledge regarding the financial condition of the Suppliers, unsafe conditions, health hazards, weather hazards, or climate extremes at locations to which you may travel. For information concerning possible dangers at destinations, TCU recommends contacting the Travel Warnings Section of the U.S. State Department at (202) 647-5225 or www.travel.state.gov. For medical information, TCU recommends contacting the Centers for Disease Control at (800) 232-4636 or www.cdc.gov/travel. You assume full and complete responsibility for (i) checking, verifying and complying with any and all passport, visa, vaccination, or other entry requirements of your destination(s), and (ii) all conditions regarding health, safety, security, political stability, and labor or civil unrest at such destination(s). You hereby knowingly and freely release TCU, and agree to hold TCU harmless, from any and all liability, claims, actions, and causes of action arising directly or indirectly out of anything covered by this paragraph.

You agree that the federal and state courts within the Northern District of Indiana will be the exclusive jurisdiction for all claims brought by you or TCU, and you hereby submit to the personal jurisdiction of those courts.

For your protection, we strongly recommend that you purchase trip cancellation insurance and that you check the appropriate box below. We also strongly recommend that you use a credit card for your purchase, so that you can exercise your rights under the Fair Credit Billing Act if you do not receive the services you purchased.
